- What strategies or actions for report back procedures do you recommend for a non-geographically based vs. a geographically placed sample, or for an occupationally defined population?
- What comparison values from other biomonitoring programs could be used to provide context for communicating results?
- What do you define as a “sufficiently responsible approach” for the CECBP to follow to report results to individuals?

# Guiding Questions for Discussion

- As part of the recruitment and informed consent processes, how should CECBP inform participants of the likely inability of linking health effects with body burden levels?
- What considerations should CECBP give to capacity building for participants, community and health care providers?
- How can individual care providers be integrated into results communication/report back efforts?
