

4-t-Octylphenol Fact Sheet

4-t-Octylphenol is an industrial chemical used to make rubber products, such as tires. It is also used to make detergents and other products, such as adhesives and inks.

4-t-Octylphenol is found in	 Rubber products, like tires. Recycled rubber products, including artificial turf for athletic fields and playgrounds and rubber gardening mulch. Some detergents, adhesives, inks, paints, and varnishes.
Possible health concerns	Scientists are still studying how 4-t-octylphenol may affect people's health. There is concern that 4-t-octylphenol: • May interfere with the body's natural hormones. • May affect the reproductive system.
Possible ways to reduce exposure	 Based on studies conducted so far, exposure to 4-t-octylphenol is expected to be very low for most people. No actions are suggested to reduce exposure.
