ADHD diagnosis	9 year olds	3.5 µg/L	5.2 µg/L	Farias et al., 2010
Bayley MDI	1 year olds	20–28 µg/L	>28 µg/L	Claus Henn et al., 2010
IUGR	Newborns: Cord blood	38.2 µg/L	44.7 µg/L	Vigeh et al., 2008
