Report back on studies

- Asian/Pacific Islander Community Exposures Project – Phases 1 and 2
- Foam Replacement Environmental Exposure Study (FREES)
- California Regional Exposure (CARE) Study
- East Bay Diesel Exposure Project

Laboratory updates, including:

- Expansion of phenols and phthalates panels
- New work on PFASs
 - Analyses in participants' urine and drinking water in a pilot study
 - Development of high throughput method
- Lab collaboration to measure serum cotinine in maternal samples
- Progress on non-targeted/semi-targeted screening
 - Studies in vulnerable populations like female firefighters and mother-infant pairs

Chemical selection

- Pending item: Chemicals used in UV applications
 - Benzophenones
 - Phenolic benzotriazoles

- Demonstrate new website findings feature
