Asian/Pacific Islander Community Exposures (ACE) Project

- Measures metals and perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFASs) in Chinese adults living in the San Francisco Bay Area
- Community partner: APA Family Support Services
- Initial enrollment goal: ~40-60 participants, expanded to 100 participants
 - Recruitment completed!



Foam Replacement Environmental Exposure Study

- Compares levels of PBDEs and OPFRs before and after foam furniture replacement
- Two participation tracks: SF/East Bay and San Jose
 - San Francisco/East Bay
 - Shifts in participant pool
 - Second round of results projected for December
 - San Jose
 - First sample collection is complete
 - Results projected for December



Expanded BEST

- Measured environmental chemical exposures in ~350 Kaiser Permanente members from California's Central Valley
- Of the 30 original participants with elevated arsenic in the initial sample, 15 participated in a retest and follow-up exposure survey
- Results for 5 of the 15 participants were again elevated
- Third round of retesting underway

Environmental Justice Projects: Community Outreach

- Community Outreach
 - Identifying EJ communities
 - Conducting listening sessions to identify priorities and potential for biomonitoring
 - Building relationships for future work



Environmental Projects: Community Studies

- Asian/Pacific Islander Community Exposures (ACE) Project II
 - Expansion of ACE project to include Vietnamese community
 - Partnering with the Vietnamese Voluntary Foundation (VIVO) in San Jose
 - Recruitment projected to begin in April 2017
- Diesel Exposure in Parent-Child Pairs
 - Comparison of exposures across neighborhoods and age groups
 - Sample collection in two seasons



Statewide Sampling Challenges

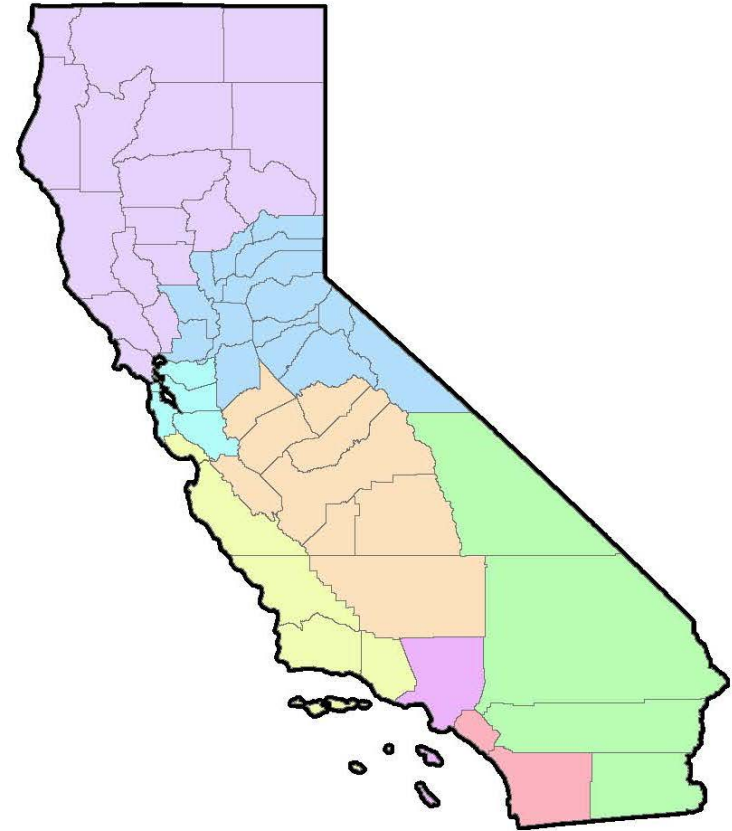
- Recruiting a representative participant pool
- Obtaining detailed exposure information
- Obtaining blood/urine samples
- Covering the state within a 2-3 year cycle
- Funding climate – uncertainty regarding resources

Statewide Sampling: Potential Approaches

- Existing surveys
 - California Health Interview Survey (CHIS)
 - Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS)
 - Other CDPH surveys
- Other State biomonitoring programs
- GDSP – Biobank samples

Multi-Regional Sampling Plan

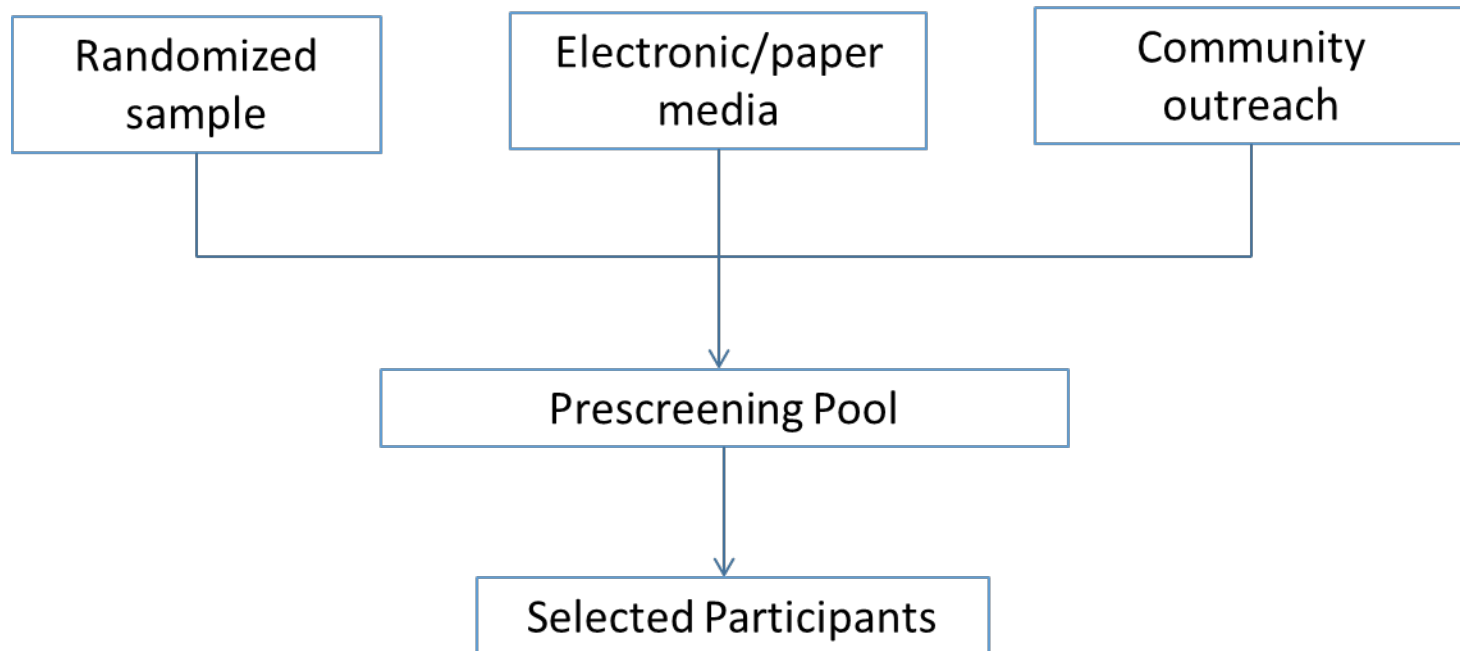
- 8 regions in California
- Proposed coverage of 2-3 regions per year (3 year sampling cycle)
- Randomized recruitment combined with community outreach
- Prescreening to ensure coverage by race, age group, and geography
